## SCHEDULE "A"

ALL that certain lot of land situate upon the eastern side of Pleasant Street in the Town of Dartmouth and the County of Halifax, and being a portion of the Lot numbered 2 upon a plan of Sud-division of the J. Walter Allison property made by R.J. Milgate, and dated November 30, 1929, the said parcel being particularly described as follows:

COMMENCING at the point where the north-eastern margin of Pleasant Street is intersected by the northern boundary of lands now or formerly owned and occupied by one McNult as shown upon the said plan;
