FISH PERMIT Whyman Hilchie

At a recent meeting a recommendation was made that Mr. Whyman Hilchie be granted a Fish Permit for the purpose of jobbing and wholesaling fish. Since receiving his permit Mr. Hilchie has been found peddling fish on the Ferry Wharf. In view of this action, as the result of complaints, it is recommended that the permit be cancelled.
