## **ORIGIN**

January 27, 2020 meeting of the Executive Standing Committee, Item 12.2.1.

#### **LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY**

Administrative Order One – the Procedure of the Council Administrative Order, Schedule 6, Executive Standing Committee Terms of Reference, section 8 which states that the Executive Standing Committee "shall act as a review committee for matters related to the general self-governance and administration of Council as directed by the Council."

The Public Appointment Policy - Governing citizen appointments to HRM agencies, boards, committees, commissions, and external bodies approved by Halifax Regional Council in August 2011.

#### **RECOMMENDATION**

The Executive Standing Committee recommends that Halifax Regional Council direct that the Advisory Committee on Accessibility be consulted in ride share discussions with the Province and transportation network companies.

January 20, 2020 meeting of the Advisory Committee for Accessibility in HRM, Item No. 15.1.

#### **LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY**

Administrative Order 2017-005-GOV, respecting the Advisory Committee for Accessibility in the Halifax Regional Municipality section 6 (b):

### **Duties of the Committee**

- 6. The Committee shall advise Council, through the Executive Standing Committee, on matters related to persons with disabilities as follows:
- (a) review and monitor existing and proposed Municipal by-laws to promote full participation of persons with disabilities:
- (b) identify and advise on the accessibility of existing and proposed municipal services and facilities.

### **RECOMMENDATION**

The Advisory Committee on Accessibility recommends that the Executive Standing Committee recommends that Halifax Regional Council direct that the Advisory Committee on Accessibility be consulted in ride share discussions with the Province and transportation network companies.

#### **BACKGROUND**

At the January 20, 2020 meeting of the Advisory Committee on Accessibility in HRM, it was noted that integrated mobility alternative business models that include accessible, on-demand, pre-booked transportation services solution through mobile, desktop and kiosk applications, such as had been presented to the Committee by MUVE Inclusive Technology Solutions in June, 2019, could not be introduced into the Municipality until the Municipality had concluded the vehicle for hire licensing program review currently underway.
