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By-law C-501 Schedule B Vending Sites

A. Food Service Vehicle Sites:

- 2. Spring Garden Road, North Side, 32.5 metres East of Brunswick Street
- 3. Grafton Street, West Side, 25 metres North of Spring Garden Road
- 6. Argyle Street, East Side, 20 metres North of Carmichael Street
- 8. Purdys Lane, North side of the north loop of the crescent, 27 metres East of Upper Water Street
- 9. Waterfront Drive, East side, 35 metres North of driveway to Park Parking Lot
- 10. Dingle Road, in the Sir Sandford Fleming Park Parking Lot
- 11. Point Pleasant Park Parking Lot at Black Rock Beach

B. Food Stand Sites:

- 11. On the Halifax North Common, Cunard Street, South Side, 48 metres East of Princess Place
- 12. On the Halifax Central Common, 5816 Cogswell Street, 199 metres East of Bell Road

C. Artisans and Craft People Sites:

- 1. On the sidewalk, North side of Spring Garden Rd (Public Gardens) between South Park Street and Summer Street (Non-food merchandise only)
- 2. Sackville Landing, 9 sites located on the Event Plaza at the SE side of Sackville Street and Lower Water Street
- 3. Nathan Greene Square, 10 sites located in park area east of Provincial Courts building, north of Ferry Terminal building.

Vending License Info Sheet

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

What are the types of Vending Licences?

Food Service Vehicle /

Stand Site license - means a license to vend food products at a specific site.

Bicycle Wagon license - means a license to vend from a bicycle wagon.

Artisan Stand license - means a license to vend handmade crafts at a specific site.

What are the types of vending?

A bicycle wagon means a bicycle vehicle propelled by human power use for vending.

A Food Service Vehicle means any vehicle, as defined in the Motor Vehicle Act, used for the display, storing, transportation or sale of food and non-alcoholic beverages by a vendor, which is required to be licensed and registered pursuant to the Motor Vehicle Act.

A stand is means any table, showcase, bench rack, pushcart, wagon or any other wheeled vehicle or device which is used for the display, storage, transportation or sale of food, non – alcoholic beverages or other merchandise by vendor.

An Artisan means a painter, photographer, silversmith, weaver, jeweller, candle maker, leather worker or other like artisan who resides in Nova Scotia and manufactures their own products or vends handmade products made within Nova Scotia.

What do I need to apply for a food service license?

- Criminal Record Report
- Photograph of stand, mobile canteen or bicycle wagon
- Copy of Photo Identification (example, Nova Scotia driver's license)
- Written consent from the owner (if applicant is not the owner of the food service vehicle or stand)
- Copy of valid Health Permit
- Proof of Insurance \$2,000,000 Coverage (Certificate of Insurance naming Halifax Regional Municipality as Addition Insured)

What do I as an Artisan need to apply for a stand license?

- Photograph of the crafts being sold
- Copy of Photo Identification (example, Nova Scotia driver's license)
- Price list for all items sold
- A statement to the effect that the applicant made or manufactured the handcraft, or the handcrafts are made within Nova Scotia.
