Reason:			
In August 2018 Halifax Regional Council considered a supplementary staff report which detailed options to expand other property types outside of residential properties (section 4) into the financing program contemplated in By-law C1000. Currently, By-law C-1000 does not allow for the inclusion of commercial, recreational, or resource properties to participate in the financing program. This excludes a large number of property and small business owners in rural areas of HRM that may experience inadequate water supply issues and do not have financing options. The staff report will explore options available to allow these property types within in the financing program.
