## 1. Age



While the exact construction date is unknown, research shows that the dwelling was likely constructed between 1900 and 1905



## **2. Architectural Importance**



- In the late 1800s, an unprecedented number of new homes were built
- The Late Victorian Plain (1880-1915) style was a popular design choice
- Emergence of the Halifax Box style
- Subject site is a good representation of the Halifax Box style
- The style was once prevalent along Agricola, but is very rare today



## **4. Architectural Merit**



- The dwelling uses construction practices associated with the Halifax Box style
- Likely an early example of wood platform framing
- Displays many Halifax Box features:
  - Two-storey design
  - Box shape
  - Wooden shingles
  - Flat roof
  - Bay windows
  - Decorative cornice
