








# 1. Age

HAC Score: 9 / 25




### **2. Architectural Importance**



- Baroque architectural style
- Style relies on balanced designs, symmetry, simple rooflines and un-complicated, yet decorative moldings
- Few early-20<sup>th</sup> Century civic buildings in Dartmouth
- Few sandstone buildings in HRM



# **3. Significance of Architect**



- Joined the Department of Public Works in 1884
- Chief Architect of the Department (1897-1914)
- Designed over 340 government buildings in Canada, including the Royal Canadian Mint in Ottawa
- Halifax Customs House



# **4. Architectural Merit**

HAC Score: 18 / 20

- Interior structure is steel and brick
- Exterior was constructed of sandstone brick; also incorporates granite
- Character defining elements:
  - 5-bay façades
  - Central entrances
  - Large window sills & voussoirs
  - "Post Office" lettering
  - Moulded lintels and brackets
  - Cornice & string course
