## 2. Architectural Importance



- Baroque architectural style
- Style relies on balanced designs, symmetry, simple rooflines and un-complicated, yet decorative moldings
- Few early-20 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ Century civic buildings in Dartmouth
- Few sandstone buildings in HRM

## 3. Significance of Architect



- Joined the Department of Public Works in 1884
- Chief Architect of the Department (1897-1914)
- Designed over 340 government buildings in Canada, including the Royal Canadian Mint in Ottawa
- Halifax Customs House

## 4. Architectural Merit

- Interior structure is steel and brick
- Exterior was constructed of sandstone brick; also incorporates granite
- Character defining elements:
- 5-bay façades
- Central entrances
- Large window sills \& voussoirs
- "Post Office" lettering
- Moulded lintels and brackets
- Cornice \& string course
