SUBJECT: 2020 Councillor Appointments to Various Boards, Committees, and Commissions

#### **ORIGIN**

Requirement to fill Councillor positions on various Boards, Committees, and Commissions.

#### LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY

Administrative Order One - The Procedures of the Council Administrative Order.

- 4 (2) Notwithstanding subsection (1), any one or more of the rules of procedures contained herein except for sections 5 and 41 and subsections 12(5) and 59(3) may be suspended by Council, Committee of the Whole, Community Council or a Standing Committee by the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3rds) of the Members present and voting.
- 119. A report with recommendations for nomination and appointment shall be brought forward to the appropriate nominating or appointing body in accordance with the *HRM Charter*, the Public Appointment Policy and Terms of Reference adopted by the Council.
- 120. (1) The motion for the election of Members by the Council to Standing Committees shall be made in November of every second year.

#### Police Board By-law

- 4 (5) Where Council is appointing or reappointing a member of the Board, Council shall consider:
  - (a) if the Board reflects the diversity of the community it represents;
  - (b) if the Board has a member with legal knowledge or knowledge of the justice

system; and

(c) if the Board has a member with financial knowledge.

#### **RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that Halifax Regional Council:

- Suspend the rules of procedures requiring the Executive Standing Committee and Community Councils to review the nominations outlined in this report and make a recommendation to Halifax Regional Council;
- 2) Appoint the Councillors to Boards, Committees and Commissions for a term to November 2022, as outlined in Attachment 1; and
- 3) Appoint the Councillors to Boards, Committees and Commissions who are the successful candidates after a vote by secret ballot for a term to November 2022, (and two of the Councillors to the Halifax Water Board of Commissioners for a term to November 2023), as outlined in Attachment 2.

#### **BACKGROUND**

Halifax Regional Council has a number of Boards, Committees and Commissions on which members of Council serve in accordance with the Terms of Reference of those bodies. Current appointments expire on November 30, 2020 and new appointments are required to fill vacancies on Standing Committees as well as Boards, Committees and Commissions.

#### DISCUSSION

An expression of interest was issued from the Office of the Municipal Clerk to all duly elected members of Regional Council regarding interest in serving on various Standing Committees, Boards, Committees and Commissions. The results of the survey have been compiled into two attachments, Attachment 1 outlines where there are sufficient vacancies to accommodate each Councillor, and Attachment 2 reflects where there are more applications from members of Council than vacancies.

The report does not reflect the full slate of appointments required by Regional Council. Some committee appointments, such as to the Executive Standing Committee and the Heritage Advisory Committee, will be made by recommendation from the newly formed Standing Committees and then be ratified by Regional Council.

It is customary for the appointments of Members of Council to be presented to the Executive Standing Committee for review. However, staff has recommended that Council suspend section 4, Membership Selection of Schedule 6 of Administrative Order One (AO1), Executive Standing Committee Terms of Reference. Section 4 states:

4. The Executive Standing Committee shall act as the Membership Selection Committee of the Council with a mandate to function as the nomination committee for appointment to Boards and Committee, including at large nomination to Standing Committees, except as delegated to other Standing Committees of Council.

Regional Council is required, by motion, to confirm the appointment of Members of Council to these bodies. In accordance with AO1, clause 120 (3)(c) "where more than the required for the committee of Council stand for election, a vote shall be taken by secret ballot." Because the meeting is being held virtually, the Clerks Office has engaged ICT to use Survey Monkey to conduct the votes as required. Use of Survey Monkey for this purpose has been reviewed by Access and Privacy who have given general approval as there are no means to identify how people vote.

#### **Halifax Regional Water Commission Terms**

As set out in Schedule 5 of AO1 and section 12 of the *Halifax Regional Water Commission Administrative*, one of the four Councillors appointed to the Halifax Regional Water Commission Board of Directors is to be nominated by the Environment and Sustainability Standing Committee (ESSC), and the remaining three appointments are nominated by the Executive Standing Committee. To follow the same approach for other appointments, only the requirement for a nomination by the Executive Standing Committee is being suspended. Accordingly, the recommendation in this report is to proceed to make three out of the four total appointments. The remaining appointment will come forward at a later date once the ESSC has made its nomination.

Halifax Water has requested that Council consider staggering terms for the four (4) Councillors appointed to the Halifax Water Board of Commissioners to provide better continuity.

The Halifax Regional Water Commission Act states:

4 (4) Each Commissioner appointed pursuant to clause (1)(a) holds office for a term of <u>two</u> or three years at the discretion of the Council

Accordingly, it is recommended that Regional Council:

- appoint two Councillors to the Halifax Water Board for terms until November 2023,
- appoint one Councillor to the Halifax Water Board for a term to November 2022, and
- following the nomination made by ESSC approve an additional Councillor appointment for a term to November 2022.

#### **Ex-Officio Appointments**

A number of bodies include Members of Council in their composition Ex-Officio (by right of office). Since the membership is defined by the office of the Member, a motion of Council is not required. Ex officio appointments involving Members of Council include:

Mayor Savage serves as Chair of the Executive Standing Committee and Ex-Officio to all HRM Committees

#### **FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS**

There are no significant risks associated with the recommendations in this Report. The risks considered rate Low.

#### **ALTERNATIVES**

It may be determined that the rules should not be waived in order to expedite Councillor appointments. This approach is not recommended because delays in appointments will result in significant delays to the composition of other boards, committees and commissions.
