HALIFAX TRANSIT ROUTE 415 CHANGES

Effective November 23rd, the last trip on the Route 415 Purcells Cove has been cancelled and an earlier trip added. The intent of this change is to allow students from Cunard Junior High the opportunity to catch the bus at the end of the school day. The last trip on Route 415 has had low ridership with an average of five or less passengers. AFFORDABLE HOUSING



On November 24th, Regional Council passed the <u>Rapid Housing Initiative investment plan</u>, to be submitted to the Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation, in order to accept \$8,659,527 in funding for the creation of a minimum of 28 permanent affordable housing units, although; our applicants are proposing to create 52 units..

In October 2020, the <u>Federal Government launched</u> <u>a new Rapid Housing Initiative (RHI)</u> that invests \$1 billion dollars to create up to 3,000 new permanent, affordable housing units across Canada.

This RHI covers the construction of modular housing, as well as the acquisition of land, and the conversion of existing buildings into affordable housing options. The funding is much needed and will help municipalities address urgent housing needs for those who are vulnerable. To learn more, see <u>here</u>.

PROVINCE ANNOUNCES RENT CONTROLS

Recently, The Honourable Chuck Porter, Minister of Housing and Municipal Affairs, ordered the following under the Emergency Measures Act:


• Rents cannot increase by more than two per cent per year (retroactive to September 1, 2020)



• Landlords will not be able to get an eviction order for renovations

These measures will be in effect until the provincial state of emergency is lifted or until February 1, 2022.

Dr. Karenga created this festival for Afro-Americans as a response to the commercialism of Christmas.
