- Established under the Halifax Convention Centre Act operates as Events East Group
- Purpose is to maintain and manage the Halifax Convention Centre to promote economic development, tourism and industry
- Province and Halifax Regional Municipality are 50/50 shareholders



Business Plan

- The Act requires Events East to submit annual business plan and budgetary estimates
- 2020-2021 Business plan submission deferred to reflect uncertainty and impact related to COVID-19
- Recent changes to public health restrictions underscore difficulty of business planning for eventsrelated businesses



Financial Implications

- Estimated 2020 funding requirement from HRM -\$5.4m, approximately double typical year
- Funding drawn from Halifax Convention Centre reserve
- Budget assumptions include restrictions on gathering limits and travel
