From Cadet to Regular Member

 Upon the successful completion of the Cadet Training Program, the new Member is transferred to their first posting and paired with a "Field Coach".

 The New Member who enters the Field Coaching Program stage of training will be required to apply the knowledge and skills learned in the Cadet Training Program in an operational setting under the guidance of an experiences RCMP police officer.





The Field Coaching Program

- Phase I Initial Field Coaching Practicum (Months 1 & 2)
- Phase II Field Coaching Program (Months 3 & 4)

- Phase III Field Coaching Program (Months 5 & 6)
 - Community Policing Exercise ("Community Profile Partner Agency Exercise"), which will enhance their knowledge through reading, interviews, and discussions with colleagues, police experts, community leaders, and citizens.
