Subject: Policing Services Review		
Motion for Council to Consider: That Halifax Regional Council direct the CAO to prepare a report, based on a review of the current model of delivering policing services in Halifax Regional Municipality, to provide an evaluation of and make recommendations with respect to the effectiveness along with community safety standards of the current division of policing responsibilities in HRM between the Halifax Regional Police and the RCMP in their capacity as Nova Scotia Provincial Police.		
Reason: The Halifax Regional Municipality is served by both the Halifax Regional Police and the Royal Canadian Mounted Police Force. Halifax Regional Police is responsible for policing the urban core of Halifax as well as the Sambro Loop and the Purcells Cove – Herring Cove Loop, the remaining areas are policed by the Halifax District RCMP and units such as the Criminal Investigation Division are complete integrated with officers from both services investigating crimes that have occurred throughout the municipality.		
This review would provide a comprehensive evaluation that will allow councillors to better understand the strengths and areas of possible improvement for the current system.		
Outcome Sought: Staff report reviewing the current model of delivering policing services to assistant in determining how to improve policing in HRM
