Subject: Changes to Beaver Bank, Hammonds Plains and Upper Sackville LUB			
Motion for Council to Consider: That North West Community Council request a staff report to consider amending the Beaver Bank, Hammonds Plains and Upper Sackville Land Use Bylaw under MU-1 zoning to allow for additional uses for children beyond daycare and education. The report should also consider creation of a new category(ies) within the MU-1 zoning to allow for businesses supporting children's developmental activities.			
Plains, a community with a high population of underserved young children. The new school being built on Larry Uteck is a result of the high population of young families in the area. Businesses hoping to open in Hammonds Plains and offer children's developmental activities are incumbered by HRM's requirement for a lengthy Development Agreement process.			
<b>Outcome Sought:</b> Staff report recommending modernized changes to the Land Use Bylaw to allow additional uses for children's activities in facilities within the MU-1 zone in Hammonds Plains.
