Location:

55 Kearney Lake Road and 4 Grosvenor Road, Halifax

Site History:

- HWCC approved one development agreement for both properties in 2019;
- Use prior to DA:
 - → 55 Kearney Lake Road: Non-conforming daycare for 38 children
 - \rightarrow 4 Grosvenor Road: illegal daycare use

Request:

Discharge an existing development agreement

Existing DA allows:

- An increase to the maximum permitted number of children in the daycare at 55 Kearney Lake Road from 38 to 40;
- Up to 40 children in the daycare at 4 Grosvenor Road;



Land Transfer (HRM Street ROW)






Halifax Mainland Land Use By-law

R-1 (Single Family Dwelling) Zone

Permitted uses:

- Single unit dwelling;
- Day care facility for up to 8 children within a dwelling;
- Office of a professional person within a dwelling;
- Home occupation;
- Special care home for up to ten people;
- Accessory uses.
- → Daycare at 55 Kearney Lake Road is a legal non-conforming use – could continue with up to 38 children if DA is discharged



ΗΛLΙΓΛΧ

Halifax Regional Municipality Charter

Discharge is enabled by Section 244 of the Halifax Regional Municipality Charter:

244 (1) A development agreement is in effect until discharged by the Council.

(2) The Council may discharge a development agreement, in whole or in part, in accordance with the terms of the agreement or with the concurrence of the property owner.

(3) After a development agreement is discharged, the land is subject to the land-use by-law.

• Approve the proposed discharging agreement as set out in Attachment A of the staff report dated August 10, 2021
