<u>ORIGIN</u>

September 13, 2021 meeting of North West Community Council, Item 13.2.1.

LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY

The Halifax Regional Municipality Charter, Part 1, Section 25(e) provides:

25 The powers and duties of a community council include

(e) making recommendations to the Council respecting any matter intended to improve conditions in the community including, but not limited to, recommendations respecting

 (i) inadequacies in existing services provided to the community and the

(i) inadequacies in existing services provided to the community and the manner in which they might be resolved, additional services that might be required and the manner in which the costs of funding these services might be raised, and
 (ii) the adoption of policies that would allow the people of the community to participate more effectively in the governance of the community;

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that Halifax Regional Council request a staff report on the intersection of Hammonds Plains and Lucasville roads to include:

- 1. recommendations to upgrade the intersection to ease the congestion of both west bound and east bound traffic;
- 2. appropriately plan for transit in this intersection;
- 3. increase pedestrian safety in this intersection.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

At their September 13, 2021 meeting, North West Community Council received a request for consideration form dated August 30, 2021 from Councillor Lovelace requesting a staff report regarding improvements to the Lucasville – Hammonds Plains Intersection.

Motion for consideration:							
That North West Community Council direct the Chief Administrative Officer to return to North West Community Council with a report on the intersection of Hammonds Plains and Lucasville roads to include:							
 Recommendations to upgrade the intersection to ease the congestion of both west bound and east bound traffic; Appropriately plan for transit in this intersection; Increase pedestrian safety in this intersection; Recommendations on lifting the restrictions of Schedule J to permit new connector roads off Hammonds Plains. 							
Reason: Traffic is often at a standstill during rush hours on Hammonds Plains road and backed up for many kilometers, however, the congestion is now occurring outside the commuter rush hours. The west bound traffic turning right hold up the traffic and the east bound traffic turning left hold up the traffic flow. The future transit route on Lucasville Road will require a more effective intersection.							
Outcome Sought: A staff report on recommendations to upgrade the Lucasville Hammonds Plains intersection mobility for traffic, transit, and pedestrians.
