Subject: Heritage Registration St Mary's Boat Club	
Motion: That Regional Council direct the CAO to provide a staff report examining the potential for including 1641 Fairfield Road also known as the St. Mary's Boat Club, in the registry of heritage properties for Halifax Regional Municipality. The report should be referred to the Heritage Advisory Committee for evaluation.	
Reason: St. Mary's Boat Club is one of the last remaining public recreation facilities along the Northwest Arm. Built in 1905, the building and grounds have strong historical associations with public recreation in the 20th Century and the unique building remains largely unchanged.	
In order to preserve this valuable historic and cultural asset and ensure that its history is acknowledged through future upgrades, it's consideration for formal heritage designation should proceed.
