Annual cost-shared heritage property grants provided by the municipality are a key incentive to support the ongoing maintenance and repair of registered municipal heritage properties. The Municipality provides heritage grants as a means to incentivize expansion of the heritage registry, and in recognition of the important public benefit that heritage properties provide to our communities and our Region. Due to the increasing cost of necessary repairs and the evolving nature of the heritage property program, options to amend the requirements and budget of the heritage grants program are being requested.
