## Rational for Dave Cooper's project

Presently the site has barn structures that have been used in the past for equestrian activities and a mobile home that has fallen into disrepair.

The desire is to remove the mobile home from the site and build a single-family dwelling in a different location. This will be the new home of the applicant. The other desire is to repair the existing barn structures to be able to store equipment and vehicles for a tree service business the applicant presently runs.

The remaining lots are to be for single family homes that meet the existing land use by-laws and zoning.

What wishes would the applicant like in the Development Agreement?

- 1. Be able to continue to use stables for equestrian use.
- 2. Be able to store wood chip piles (out of sight) to turn into mulch and compost. This would help Arbor become a carbon neutral company.
- 3. Use part of stables as a greenhouse.
- 4. Store equipment inside.
- 5. Have a shop to work on gear to do minor repairs and maintenance.
- 6. A little office space where we can do paperwork and have safety meetings.

Improvements to the property:

- 1. Remove mobile trailer.
- 2. Remove graffiti from buildings.
- 3. Set up a residence and have a presence on the property to keep people from partying and making noise on the property. Better neighbors and quieter than it is now.
- 4. Plant trees to screen barn, improve aesthetics of the property and to help Arbor become a carbon neutral company.
- 5. Keep grass mowed to improve aesthetics.
- 6. Improve landscaping and plant plants around the stables.
