

# **Equity Considerations**

#### **Narrative 1**

- Stormwater ROW charge is for benefit received by HRM roads
- HRM road costs are funded by all general rates. Similarly, provincial roads are funded by all residents in HRM (through provincial taxes)

#### **Narrative 2**

- Within municipal stormwater service area, Halifax Water (HW) collects site-generated charge from 89% of all properties
- Resource and other properties with limited development (less than 50m²), as well as properties that drain away from HW infrastructure, are excluded
- HRM area rate could include all properties within service area

# **History of Funding**

Fiscal Year	<b>Collection Method</b>	Charge Amount
2013-14	HRM general fund	\$0 (funded through surplus)
2014-15	Halifax Water bill	\$39/HW client
2015-16	Halifax Water bill	\$41/HW client
2016-17	HRM flat area rate	\$42/HRM tax account
2017-18	Halifax Water bill	\$39/HW client
2018-19 to present	Halifax Water bill	\$40/HW client

# **Current Funding Method**

Stormwater ROW charge is collected (on HRM's behalf) by Halifax Water on all properties that pay HW's site-generated stormwater fee.

Currently, \$40/year; estimated to increase to \$51 next year (depending on a number of outstanding factors).

#### <u>Pros</u>

No change required; administration is well managed

#### Cons

- Doesn't reflect who benefits from HRM roads.
- Many HRM residents who use HRM roads do not pay Stormwater ROW charge.



# **Option 1 – General Rate**

Fund Stormwater ROW costs from general rate.

Rate estimated to be 0.9 cent on the 2023/24 tax bill or \$25 per average home. Higher costs to larger apartments and commercial properties. All property owners will pay, including 30,000+ outside municipal stormwater service area.

#### <u>Pros</u>

Aligns with HRM tax structure – road costs are general rated.
 Shares costs among all those who benefit from HRM roads.
 Not a separate charge to draw attention.

#### Cons

• Will show up as tax increase in 2023/24, even though net cost impact across the region is \$0.



## **Option 2 – Area Rate**

Fund Stormwater ROW costs through an area rate across the municipal stormwater service area.

Rate estimated to be 1.1 cent on the 2023/24 tax bill or \$30 per average home. Higher costs to larger apartments and commercial properties. Would include those (approx.11,500) not currently paying the site-generated stormwater charge.

#### <u>Pros</u>

Includes all property owners within the municipal stormwater service area.

#### Cons

- Doesn't reflect who benefits from HRM roads.
- Many HRM residents who use HRM roads would not pay the rate.
- Will create a very visible area rate on the tax bill, prompting questions.



## **Decision Matrix** (from a benefits perspective)

### Recommendation (deferred from March 1, 2022)

- It is recommended that Halifax Regional Council maintain By-Law C-900 and direct the Chief Administrative Officer to maintain By-Law C-900 and the current HRM stormwater right-of-way charge of \$40 per Halifax Water stormwater client, collected on behalf of HRM on the Halifax Water bill.
- Note: The \$40 charge is in place for 2022/23. If the current funding approach remains in place, the 2023/24 annual per property charge will be updated to provide the required Halifax Water payment, as decided by the NS Utility and Review Board.
