<ul> <li>That Halifax Regional Council direct the Chief Administrative Officer to provide a staff report evaluating a potential Gravel Road Paving Program for HRM-owned roads that considers an annual funding allocation and the following prioritization criteria: <ul> <li>Cost-benefit of paving</li> <li>Existing road condition and level of maintenance</li> <li>Road classification</li> <li>Traffic volume</li> <li>Storm water management</li> <li>Winter maintenance</li> <li>Surrounding public amenities such as parks, schools, lake access, etc.</li> </ul> </li> <li>And further, direct the Chief Administrative Officer to undertake pre-engineering work on HRM gravel roads, in accordance with Regional Council's current approved prioritization criteria, to ensure that Regional Council can consider paving up to \$500K of HRM gravel roads as part of the 2023/24 budget process.</li> </ul>
