RECOMMENDATION

The Women's Advisory Committee recommends that the Executive Standing Committee recommends to Halifax Regional Council that the Mayor be asked to write a letter to the Federal Minister of Health opposing any bill or motion that is intended to restrict abortion or reduce access to abortions in Canada.

BACKGROUND

While developing their 2022 Work Plan, the Women's Advisory Committee agreed to address issue impacting women in HRM.

The Women's Advisory Committee has received numerous presentations related to public safety and the impact on women. The Committee noted how a letter to the Federal Minister allows for HRM to be seen as an inclusive and safe place for women to live. As well, reinforces HRM's commitment to safe cities and the UN Women Safe Cities, Safe Public Spaces for Women and Girls Global Flagship Programme started in 2019.

DISCUSSION

Women's Advisory Committee members expressed interest in forming a statement opposing the overturn of the Roe v. Wade law in the United States at their July 7, 2022 meeting. The Committee considered former presentations and discussions around public safety and the impact on women and approved the motion outlined in this report.
