SUBJECT:	Community Council Nominations to Boards and Committees

ORIGIN

The requirement for Community Councils to nominate Councillors to serve on Boards, Committees and Commissions.

LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY

Administrative Order One – *The Procedures of the Council Administrative Order:* 119. A report with recommendations for nomination and appointment shall be brought forward to the appropriate nominating or appointing body in accordance with the HRM Charter, the Public Appointment Policy and Terms of Reference adopted by the Council.

120. (1) The motion for the election of Members by the Council to Standing Committees shall be made in November of every second year.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that North West Community Council recommend that Halifax Regional Council:

- 1. Appoint the Councillors to Boards, Committees and Commissions for a term to November 30, 2024, as outlined in Attachment 1; and
- 2. Appoint the Councillors to Boards, Committees and Commissions who are the successful candidates after a vote by secret ballot for a term to November 30, 2024, as outlined in Attachment 2.

BACKGROUND

Halifax Regional Council has several Boards, Committees and Commissions on which members of Council serve in accordance with the Terms of Reference of those bodies. Current appointments expire on November 30, 2022, and new appointments are required to fill vacancies on Standing Committees as well as Boards, Committees and Commissions.

DISCUSSION

North West Community Council action required:

- Nominate two (2) members of North West Community Council to serve on the Appeals Standing Committee
- Nominate one (1) member of North West Community Council to serve on the Audit and Finance Standing Committee
- Nominate one (1) member of North West Community Council to serve on the Community Planning and Economic Development Standing Committee
- Nominate one (1) member of North West Community Council to serve on the Environment and Sustainability Standing Committee
- Nominate one (1) member of North West Community Council to serve on the Transportation Standing Committee
- Nominate one (1) member of North West Community Council to serve on the Grants Committee
- Nominate two (2) members of North West Community Council to serve on the North West Planning Advisory Committee

An expression of interest was issued from the Office of the Municipal Clerk to all members of Halifax Regional Council regarding interest in serving on various Standing Committees, Boards, Committees and Commissions. The results of the survey have been compiled into two attachments. Attachment 1 outlines where there are sufficient vacancies to accommodate each Councillor, and Attachment 2 reflects where there are more applications from members of Council than vacancies.
