ORIGIN

November 17, 2022 meeting of Community Planning & Economic Development Standing Committee, Item 10.3.2.

LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY

Legislative Authority is outlined in the attached supplemental staff report dated November 14, 2022.

Administrative Order One, Respecting the Procedures of Council, Schedule 3 Community Planning & Economic Development Standing Committee Terms of Reference:

1. (1) The purpose of the Community Planning and Economic Development Standing Committee is to recommend to the Council directions to support Community and Economic life "making HRM the most livable community in which to live, work and play".

RECOMMENDATION

The Community Planning and Economic Development Standing Committee recommend that Regional Council direct the Chief Administrative Officer to:

- 1. Engage with other tenants, stakeholders and the public to obtain feedback on the project as presented at the November 17, 2022 Community Planning and Economic Development Standing Committee presentation from the Board of the Halifax Public Gardens Foundation; and
- 2. Prepare a staff report assessing the proposal for incorporation into further development of the Wanderer's Block within the context of the 2022 Halifax Common Master Plan as approved in

principle, and identifying possible funding sources, and exploring governance models for the Public Gardens as a whole.

BACKGROUND

Community Planning and Economic Development Standing Committee received a presentation from Robert Pace, Chair of the Board of Public Gardens Foundation at the November 17, 2022 meeting to consider a proposal for a public greenhouse.




