



Some accelerated progress via tactical/interim installations.














Why?

- allow for faster implementation & the ability to trial street designs on a temporary basis.
- allow time to monitor project impacts and gather feedback from users to influence the permanent designs.

Interim Bikeway Improvements

The municipality is planning to install 8.5 km of interim bikeway improvements between Fall 2022 and Spring 2023, using quick-build materials like concrete curbs, bollards, paint, and traffic calming features to make it easier and safer to cycle in Halifax and Dartmouth. These treatments will be in place until the streets can be permanently upgraded (likely within five years).

Where will these facilities be located?

Six routes have been selected in peninsular Halifax and Dartmouth within the Circumferential Highway. These represent important links in the AAA bike network that will promote connectivity and improved transitions between existing cycling facilities.
