
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





































Policy Highlights

Bike Racks on Buses Each bus is equipped with a bike rack which can hold a maximum of two bikes. Regular and ebikes are permitted; gas-powered bikes are not. Batteries on ebikes must remain connected to the ebike. You are responsible for both loading and unloading your bike.

There are two dedicated bike racks on each ferry that can accommodate up to 11 bikes total, including two spaces for fat tire bikes. Ebikes are permitted to be transported on Halifax Transit ferries as long as they are safely stored in the bike racks provided; however, gas-powered bicycles are not permitted.

Bike Racks on Ferries

Food & Drink Beverages may be consumed on Halifax Transit buses if a sealable, spill-proof container is used. Single use Beverages may be consumed on Halifax Transit buses disposable cups are not permitted. Food cannot be consumed on buses because there is a risk of spillage when the bus accelerates or decelerates. Under no circumstances is open alcohol allowed onboard or to be consumed on any Halifax Transit vehicle.

Personal Transportation Devices Skateboards, foldable manual scooters, and other manual transportation devices can now be transported on Halifax Transit conventional buses if they are folded and stored on a passenger's lap.

Motorized personal transportation devices (including Segways and hoverboards), are not permitted on board Halifax Transit buses & ferries due to associated safety risks.

Pets must be properly restrained in a closed pet container that does not exceed 16" (40.6 cm) high X 21" (53.3 cm) deep X 27" (68.6 cm) wide. Pet containers cannot block any doors, aisles, or emergency exits.



Service animals are permitted in all Halifax Transit facilities and on all vehicles and vessels. Service animals must be securely leashed and under the care and control of the owner at all times. Halifax Transit encourages customers to carry the municipally issued certification card and Service Animal Identification (ID) tags.

Smoking and vaping are permitted only within municipal designated smoking areas (DSAs).

Strollers must be smaller than 42" X 22.5" (double wide strollers are not permitted).

Accessibility

The entire Halifax Transit bus fleet and ferries are accessible.

Operators will deploy the ramp at the request of a mobility impaired passenger at any bus stop, other than those marked with a 'No Ramp Deployed' decal. Our three bus stop classifications are as follows:
