## ORIGIN

27 (1) A community council shall hold an annual public meeting in the community in each year to report to the public concerning its activities and to receive the views of the public respecting all matters within its mandate.

Administrative Order One, *The Procedures of the Council Administrative Order*, schedule 8 Community Council Rules of Governing Procedures.

#### RECOMMENDATION

#### BACKGROUND

Regional Centre Community Council was established on December 3, 2019 by Administrative Order 48, *the Community Council Administrative Order*.

# Case 24540 Robie Street Transportation Reserve Minimum Setbacks and Regional Centre Land Use By-law Housekeeping Amendment

Public Hearing held and closed. Motion approved that Regional Centre Community Council adopt the proposed amendments to the Regional Centre Land Use By-law to establish a front and flanking setback of 0.5 metre on Schedule 18 for properties abutting the Robie Street Transportation Reserve, as set out in Attachment A of the staff report dated October 12, 2022

#### Case 224492: Appeal of Variance Refusal – 1059 Wellington Street, Halifax

Variance Appeal Hearing held and closed. Motion approved that the Regional Centre Community Council allow the appeal - decision of the Development Officer was overturned.

#### Case 24350: Appeal of Variance Refusal - 6924 Armview Avenue, Halifax PID 00078881

Variance Appeal Hearing held and closed. Motion defeated that the Regional Centre Community Council allow the appeal - decision of the Development Officer upheld.
