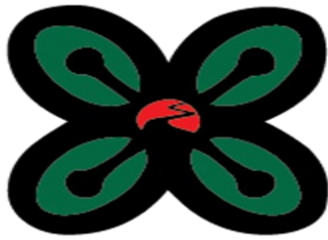
To: The Esteemed Members of the African Descent Advisory Committee (ADAC):
