## HALIFAX RELIEF COMMISSION CLAIM AND CITY'S COUNTER CLAIM

His Worship the Mayor informs the Council that Mr. Justice Rogers, Chairman of the Halifax Relief Commission, had asked for a settlement of the Claim of the Relief Commission against the City, and that as the City has a counter claim against the Commission he suggests that the matter be referred to the Finance Committee.

Moved by Alderman Weston, seconded by Alderman Smeltzer that the matter of the Claim of the Halifax Relief Commission against the City of Halifax be referred to the Finance Committee with power to adjust accounts and propose scheme of settlement subject to ratification by this Council. Motion passed unanimously.

His Worship the Mayor was requested to ask the Halifax Relief Commission to furnish the City with any claim or counter claim it may have against the City.
