Alderman Sullivan asked if any arrangements had been made to celebrate the 50th Anniversary of the Halifax Explosion on December 6, 1967.

His Worship the Mayor stated that as a result of a suggestion made some time ago, tentative plans have been agreed to fora special ceremony at which the City and the Province would be joint sponsors and a special invitation has been sent from the Province on a joint basis to an outstanding figure from outside the Country to join in the ceremony. He said that when a reply has been received from the invited person, a small joint organizing committee will probably be appointed and perhaps Alderman Sullivan could be asked to

represent the City on that Committee. He advised that a Port Dinner is to be held in the evening on that date and plans are being prepared for a Noon or early afternoon ceremony.

It was then agreed that Alderman Sullivan represent the City of Halifax on the joint organizing committee.
