To His Worship the Mayor and Members of the City Council.

Gentlemen:—Herewith is submitted the annual report of the Citizens' Free Library for the year 1918-19.

Two hundred and twelve (212) bound volumes were added, seventy-seven (77) of these being magazines.

The number of books issued was nineteen thousand three hundred and thirty (19330), divided among the various classes, as follows:—

The year's work was very much interrupted, first by the closing of the Library for the repairs made necessary by the explosion; and later, by the influenza epidemic: the Library being in full working order for only about two-thirds of the year.
