Gentlemen:-

The Board of Control beg to recommend ~~that~~ for the protection of the temporary shelters on the Exhibition Grounds and for the protection of north end property generally that the Relief Commission be requested to erect a temporary fire station on the Incinerator property or give the Fire Department the use of one of the buildings at present used by the contractors on the said Incinerator property for the accommodation of a chemical engine and horses and men and that the offer of the American LaFrance Fire Engine Company to repair the motor fire engine Patricia for \$6,000.00 be accepted; the said engine when repaired to be placed in the temporary fire station proposed to be erected.
