

## FIRE DEPARTMENT - APPOINTMENT OF CHIEF AND DISTRICT CHIEF.

The City Council.

Gentlemen :-

At a meeting of the Board of Control held on the 12th inst., Controller Hines reported that Edward Condon, Chief of the Halifax Fire Department, and William Brunt, District Chief, had both been killed while on duty during the redent disaster, and that it was necessary that these two offices be filled immediately. He recommended to the Board the appointment of Captain J. W. Churchill of No. 3 Division, to the position of Chief of the Fire Department, and of J. E. Keefe, Captain of No. 7 Hose, to the position of District Chief of the Fire Department.

The applications for these positions and the recommendations of Controller Hines are attached hereto.

The Board recommends that the recommendations of Controller Hines be approved by the City Council.
