"THE TIGER" SURVIVES BULLETS OF ASSASSIN

Man Who Fired Shots at the Veteran French Statesman

Was Arrested .- He is About Twenty-five Years of Age and the Police Believe he is a Russian .-- Official Announcement Made That Premier Clemenceau Was Not Seriously Wounded.

PARIS, February 19—Georges Clemenceau, France's aged but vigorous Premier, was shot at and slightly wounded this morning as he was entering his automobile. Five shots were fired by the would-be assassin, and it was at first reported that the Premier had been wounded in the head. It developed later, however, that the wounds were in M. Clemenceau's back and shoulder and that he is not dangerously hurt.

The shooting took place at 8.55 o'clock this morning, as the Premier was leaving his house in the Rue Franklin to go to the War Office.

The assassin was an ordinary-looking man, dressed as a workman. He was arrested.

Despite his advanced years—he is 76 years old—M. Clemenceau has continued in recent months to justify the sobriqued "the Tiger," which long has been applied to him, going through the trying work of the peace conference, with its many long consultations without often showing signs of fatigue.
