Adult Award Nomination Form

Due date: 5 p.m. on Thursday, January 8, 2026.

Each year the Mayor and Halifax Regional Council recognize the the warmth and generosity of volunteers with a ceremony to celebrate the invaluable contributions of these individuals who give their time and skills in our communities.

Thank you for taking the time to nominate an outstanding individual. Please read the following criteria carefully before filling out your nomination.

NOMINATION CRITERIA

Adult volunteers, who meet the following criteria, are eligible for a volunteer award:

- Demonstrates initiative, leadership and creativity in service to others;
- serves as a role model and inspires others to engage in volunteer service;
- improves the overall quality of life of fellow citizens and the community;
- paid work cannot be listed on the form;
- volunteer must be a resident of Halifax Regional Municipality;
- nominators may only nominate one person per nomination form; and
- the volunteer cannot have received this award in the last 5 years.

This is a scored process. The top six scoring volunteers from each district will receive an award and the top scoring nominee will be the municipality's volunteer of the year — for a total of 97 adult and/or youth. The top 10 volunteers will be put forward to receive a provincial award.

Nominations that are unclear, inaccurate, late or do not comply with the criteria may not be accepted or could negatively impact your volunteer's score. All submissions must be received by the stated deadline to be considered.

AWARD SELECTION PROCESS

- All nominations are scored.
- Awards are allotted in each of the municipality's 16 electoral districts with six volunteers (at least one youth) being selected from each district, based on the nominee's score.
- All nominees and award recipients are presented to the Executive Standing Committee of Council and to Regional Council for final approval.
- Successful nominees will be invited to attend a ceremony and reception in April with the Mayor and Regional Council to receive their award.
- Nominators will receive a letter informing them of the status of their nominee.
- The top scoring nominee will be named the volunteer of the year by the municipality.
- The top ten scoring nominees will be selected to represent the municipality at the provincial volunteer awards, where they will receive a volunteer award from the province.
