



Halifax Regional Police Environmental Scan 1st Quarter 2018

Total HRP Criminal Code Offences/Drugs

Total Criminal Code offences in the first quarter of 2018 show an increase of +809 or by +23.71% compared to the first quarter of 2017.

Drugs in the first quarter of 2018 increased by +3 or by +1.63% compared to the first quarter of 2017.

In the first quarter Property offences count for 48% of the Total Criminal Code offences, while crimes against Persons account for 17% and Criminal Other offences account for 35%.

First Quarter comparison between 2017 and 2018:

Property Crimes

Overall, Property Crime increase by +369 or -22.42%.

Stolen Motor Vehicles saw no change remaining at 47 for both years.

Break and Enters increased by +8 or +4.47%.

Frauds decreased by +45 or +17.86%.

Violent Crimes

Overall Violent crime increased by +184 or +33.52%.

Robberies increased by +12 or +35.29%.

Homicides increased by +1 incidents or +100%.

Attempted Murders saw no change remaining at 1 for both years.

Assaults increased by +167 or +33.13%.

Assaults accounted for 92% of reported violent crimes in the first quarter of 2018.

Criminal Code Other

Includes solicitation, gaming/betting, offensive weapons, and other criminal code offences (arson, property damage, indecent acts, counterfeiting, etc)

Offensive Weapons increased by +2 in the first quarter of 2018 or by +5.26%

Solicitation offences decreased by -3 offences in the first quarter of 2018 or -60%

Please note offence statistics such as drug and solicitation are sensitive to directed enforcement and detection.

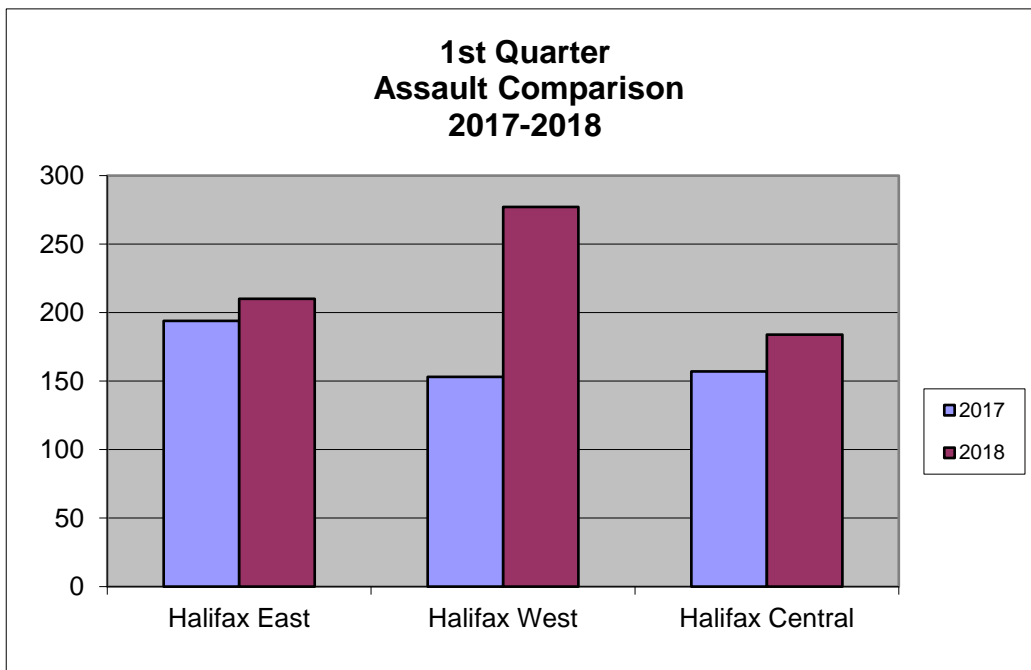

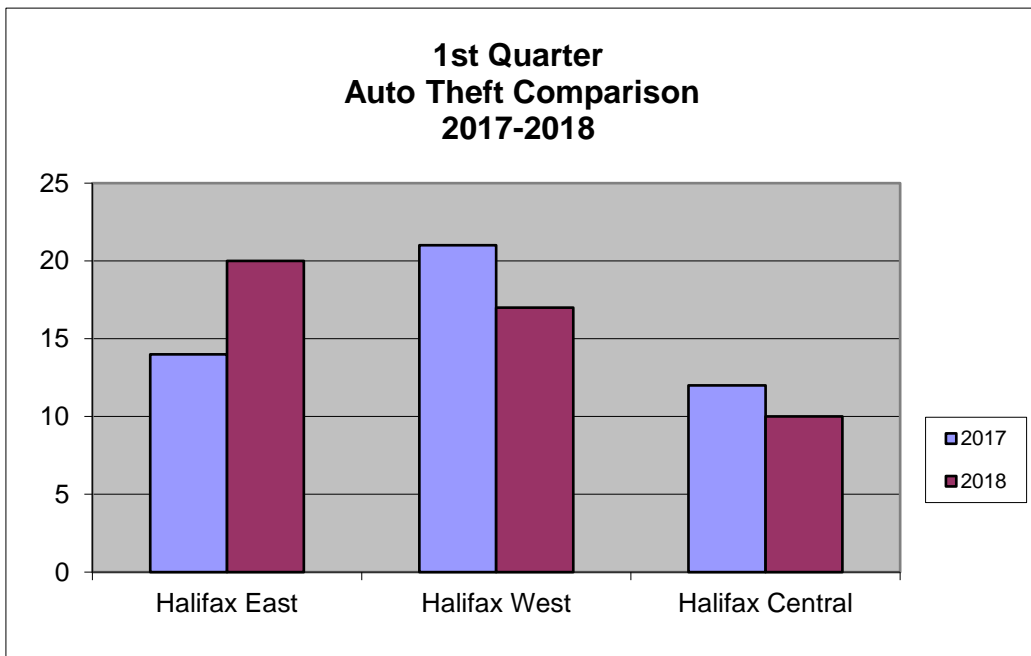
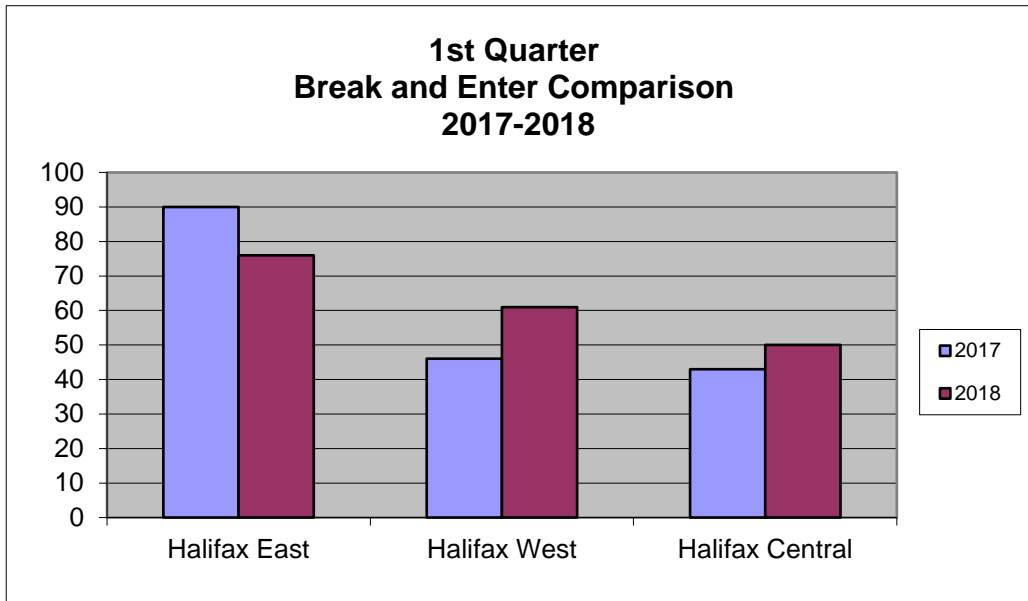

Crimes Against Persons 1st Quarter Comparison



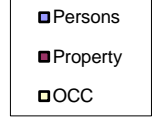
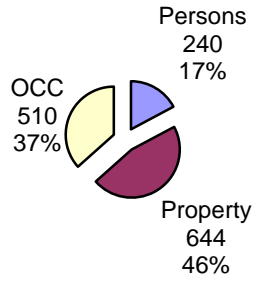
Crimes Against Property 1st Quarter Comparison



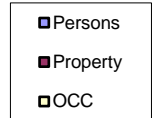
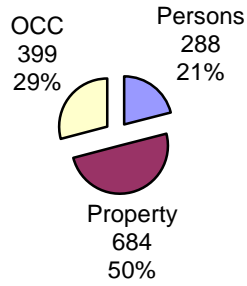
Halifax Regional Police 1st Quarter Regional Stats 2018



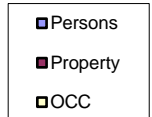
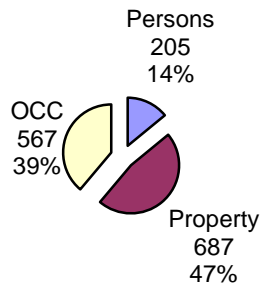
HRP 1st Quarter Stats East

HRM Policing Services Environmental Scan 1st Quarter 2018



Total HRM Criminal Code Offences/Drugs

Total Criminal Code offences in the first quarter of 2018 show an increase of +895 or by +20.49% compared to the first quarter of 2017.

Drugs in the first quarter of 2018 increased by +8 or by +3.08% compared to the first quarter of 2017.

In the first quarter Property offences count for 47% of the Total Criminal Code offences, while crimes against Persons account for 17% and Criminal Other offences account for 36%.

First Quarter comparison between 2017 and 2018:

Property Crimes

Overall Property Crime increased by +424 or +20.73%.

Stolen Motor Vehicles *increased* by +8 or +12.12%.

Break and Enters increased by +24 or +9.84%.

Frauds *increased* by +48 or +14.24%.

Violent Crimes

Overall Violent crime increased by +208 or +29.42%.

Robberies increased by +14 or +35.90%.

Homicides increased by +1, with 2 incidents in the first quarter of 2018 compared to 1 in the first quarter of 2017.

Attempted Murders remain the same with 1 in the first quarter of 2018 and 2017.

Assaults increased by +189 or +28.99%.

Assaults accounted for 92% of reported violent crimes in the first quarter of 2018.

Criminal Code Other

Includes solicitation, gaming/betting, offensive weapons, and other criminal code offences (arson, property damage, indecent acts, counterfeiting, etc)

Offensive Weapons increased by +1 in the first quarter of 2018.

Solicitation offences showed no change with 5 in the first quarter of 2018 and 2017.

Please note offence statistic such as drugs and solicitation are sensitive to directed enforcement and detection.
