- 9.1.1 HRM Police Services Review Update

Speaking from the Chair, Commissioner Craig provided the Board with an update on the progress in the recruitment for the next Chief of the Halifax Regional Police. They noted that the Search Committee, working with consultants Knightsbridge Robertson Surrette, have developed a shortlist of over thirty (30) candidates for the position. The Search Committee has completed interviews and is in the process of selecting a recommendation to forward to the Board. The Board will then forward their recommendation to Halifax Regional Council.

To date, the HRP have received approximately \$52,000, which will been used to assist in combating impaired driving.

Inspector Robert Doyle, Halifax District Detachment, RCMP, provided the Board with several personnel updates relating to senior Halifax District RCMP members.

The Chair thanked Chief Blais and Inspector Doyle for the updates.
