4. REVISED HALIFAX REGIONAL POLICE 2020/21 BUDGET

The following was before the Board:

• A presentation entitled "2020-21 HRP Budget Review"

Chief Dan Kinsella presented two additional budget scenarios with reductions of \$4.5 million and \$3.5 million for the 2020-21 Halifax Regional Police Budget Plan from the previous \$5,514,000 reduction as recommended by the Budget Committee May 20, 2020. The first scenario proposes a reduction of \$3,250,800 in compensation (19 staffing reductions) and \$1,249,200 in non-compensation. The second scenario proposed a reduction of \$2,570,300 in compensation (12 staffing reductions) and \$929,700 in non-compensation.

The Board reviewed the potential changes to the HRP budget with staff responding to questions.

MOVED by Commissioner Mancini, seconded by Commissioner Blackburn

THAT the Board of Police Commissioners recommends that the Budget Committee of Halifax Regional Council receive the Board's additional budget considerations for a budget reduction of either \$4.5 million or \$3.5 million in comparison to the proposed \$5 million budget reduction.
