## 4. CALL FOR DECLARATION OF CONFLICT OF INTERESTS

Rob Leblanc declared a conflict on Item 5 - Case 24497: Substantive Site Plan Approval for 1190 Barrington Street, advising they were a founder of Fathom Studios, which was responsible for the qualitative wind impact assessment.

## 5. CASE 24497: SUBTANTIVE SITE PLAN APPROVAL FOR 1190 BARRINGTON STREET

The following was before the Committee:

- Staff recommendation report dated October 26, 2022
- Staff presentation dated November 10, 2022

Rob Leblanc was recused from the meeting during consideration on this item, having declared a conflict of interest in the matter.

Darrell Joudrey, Planner II gave a presentation on Case 24497, spoke to the qualitative elements and variances for the Committee's consideration, and responded to questions of clarification from the Committee regarding the sunken condition of the units along the northside elevation.

Ronald Smith, Studioworks International Inc., spoke on behalf of the applicant and responded to questions of clarification from the Committee. Smith noted that the sunken condition along the northside elevation was a design compromise that would impact two units, where the alternative would have altered the floor plans for all other units.

- 3. Accept the findings of the qualitative Wind Impact Assessment, as contained in Attachment B of the staff report dated October 26, 2022; and
- 4. Recommend that the Development Officer accept the cash-in-lieu contribution required by Section 12 (6.1) of the Land Use By-law.
