HRM Policing Services Environmental Scan 1st Quarter 2017



Total HRM Criminal Code Offences/Drugs

Total Criminal Code offences in the first quarter of 2017 show an increase of +202 or by +4.61% compared to the first quarter of 2016.

Drugs in the first quarter of 2017 increased by +12 or by +4.86% compared to the first quarter of 2016.

In the first quarter Property offences count for 46% of the Total Criminal Code offences, while crimes against Persons account for 16% and Criminal Other offences account for 38%.

First Quarter comparison between 2016 and 2017:

Property Crimes

Overall Property Crime decreased by -146 or -6.48%.

Stolen Motor Vehicles decreased by -16 or -19.51%.

Break and Enters increased by +23 or +10.22%.

Frauds decreased by -37 or -10.08%.

Violent Crimes

Overall Violent crime increased by +153 or +26.26%.

Robberies increased by +2 or +5.26%.

Homicides decreased by -4, with no reported incidents in the first quarter of 2017 compared to +4 in the first quarter of 2016.

Attempted Murders decreased by -4 or -80%.

Assaults increased by +155 or +29.81%.

Assaults accounted for 92% of reported violent crimes in the first quarter of 2017.

Criminal Other Code

Includes prostitution, gaming/betting, offensive weapons, and other criminal code offences (arson, property damage, indecent acts, counterfeiting, etc)

Offensive Weapons increased by +5 in the first quarter of 2017.

Prostitution offences decreased by -20 offences in the first quarter of 2017 or -100%

Please note offences such as drug and prostitution are sensitive to directed enforcement and detection.

Assaults

Assaults Level 1 accounted for 62% of the total Assaults in the 1st quarter of 2017, the 1st quarter of 2016 had a result of 66% and experienced a +16% **increase** in 2017 over the same period last year.

Assault with a Weapon Causing Bodily Harm accounted for 11% of the total Assaults in 2017 compared to 16% in 2016 and experienced a -11% **decrease** over the same period last year.

All forms of Sexual Assaults combined accounted for 24% of the total Assaults in 2017 compared to 18% in 2016.

Robberies accounted for 3% of the total Persons Crime in the 1st quarter of 2017 compared to 7% in 2016 and experienced a -50% **decrease** in 2017 over the same period last year.

Break & Enter

Break & Enter (Residence) accounted for 58% of the total Break & Enters in the 1st quarter of 2017 compared to 49% in 2016 and experienced -12% **decrease** in the 1st quarter of 2017 compared to the same period last year.

Break & Enter (Other) accounted for 20% of the total Break & Enters in 2017 1st quarter compared to 36% in 2016 and experienced a -48% **decrease** over the same period last year.

Break & Enter (Business) accounted for 18% of the total Break & Enters in the 1st quarter 2017 compared to 14% in 2016 and experienced a +20% **increase** in 2017 over the same period last year.

Theft Under \$5,000

Theft Other Under \$5,000 accounted for 74% of the total Theft Under \$5,000 in the 1st quarter 2017 compared to 54% in 2016 and experienced a +4% **increase** in 2017 over the same period last year.

Theft from Motor Vehicle under \$5,000 accounted for 24% of the total Theft Under \$5,000 in the 1st quarter 2017 compared to 46% in 2016 and experienced a -60% **decrease** over the same period last year.

Possession of Stolen Goods combined **decreased** by -26 incidents or -74% in the 1st quarter of 2017 when compared to the same period last year.

Shoplifting Under \$5,000 experienced a +100% **increase** in the 1st quarter 2017 over the same period last year.

Environmental Scan of 2017 1st Quarter

Total District Criminal Code Offences/Drugs

Total Criminal Code offences in the first quarter of 2017 show a **decrease** of -12 or by -1.23% compared to the first quarter in 2016.

Drugs in the first quarter of 2017 **increased** by +2 or by +2.74% compared to the first quarter of 2016.

In the first quarter Property offences count for 42% of Total Criminal Code offences, while crimes against Persons account for 17% and Criminal Other offences account for 41%.

First Quarter comparison between 2016 and 2017:

Property Crimes

Overall Property Crime **decreased** by -114 or -21.92%.

Stolen Motor Vehicles **decreased** by -14 or -42.42%.

Break and Enters **decreased** by -4 or -5.80%.

Fraud incidents **decreased** by -2 or -2.27%.

Violent Crimes

Overall Violent Crime **increased** by +24 or +17.65%.

Robberies **decreased** by -5 or -50%.

Homicides remained the same at 0.

Attempted Murders **decreased** -2 or -100%.

Assaults **increased** by +28 or +22.95%.

Assaults accounted for 94% of reported violent crimes in the first quarter of 2017.

Other Criminal Code

Includes prostitution, gaming/betting, offensive weapons, and other criminal code offences (i.e. arson, property damage, indecent acts, counterfeiting currency etc.)

Offensive Weapons **increased** by +6 in the first quarter of 2017 or by +60%.

Prostitution offences remained the same at 0 in the first quarter of 2017.

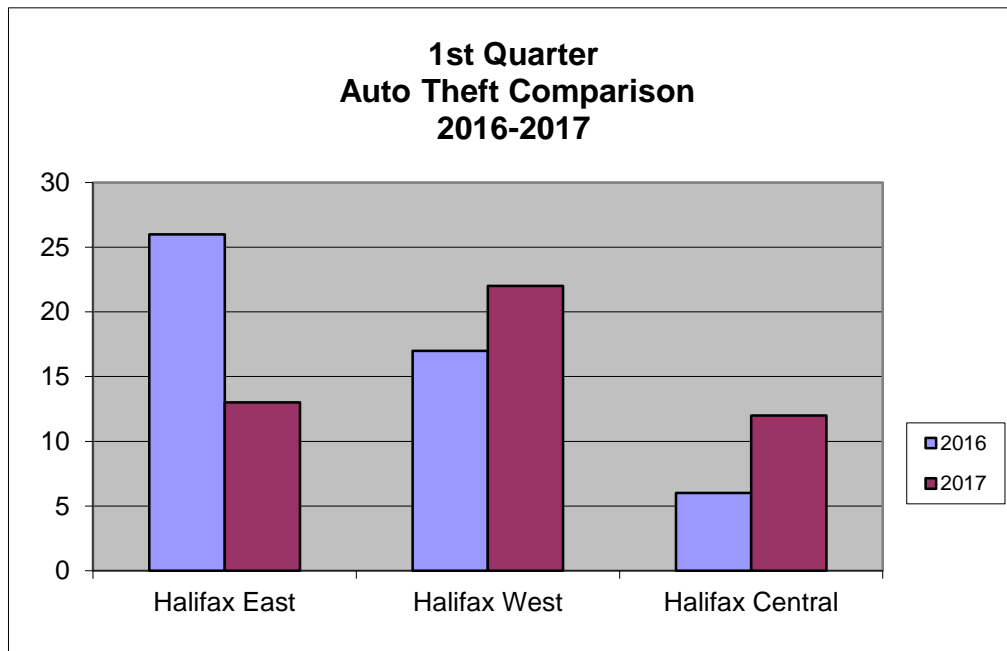

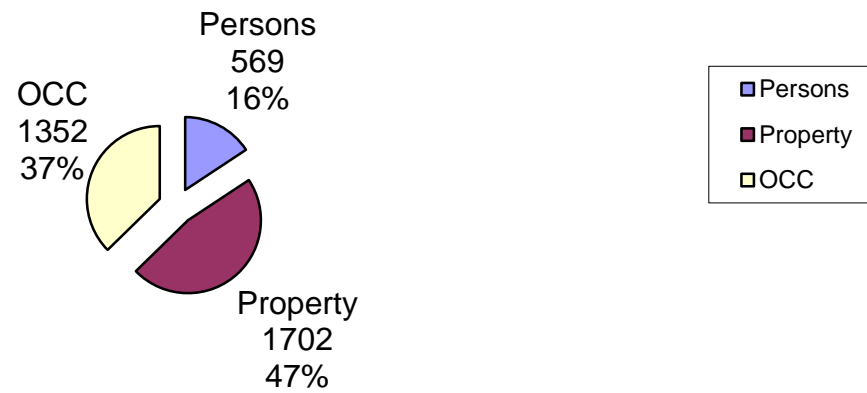
Crimes Against Persons 1st Quarter Comparison



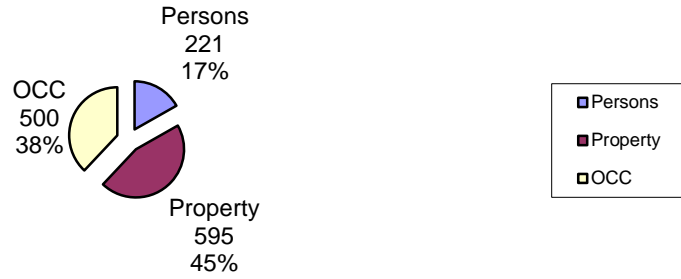
Crimes Against Property 1st Quarter Comparison



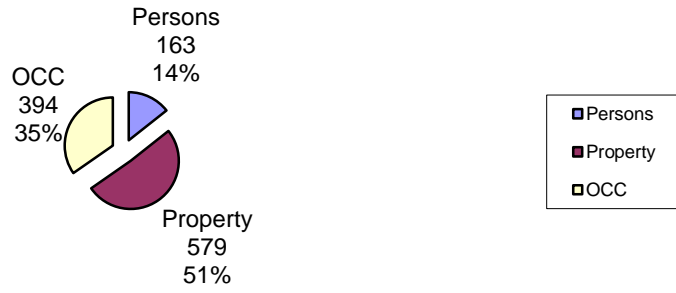
Halifax Regional Police 1st Quarter Regional Stats 2017



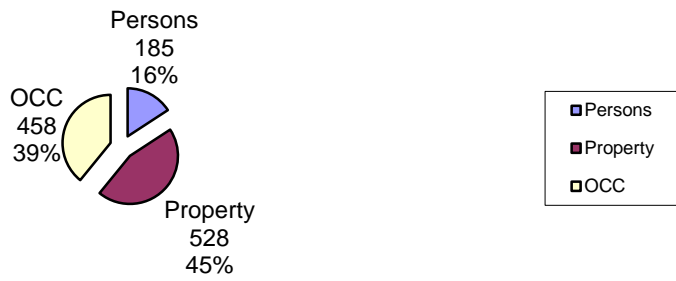
HRP 1st Quarter Stats East

Total HRP Criminal Code Offences/Drugs

Total Criminal Code offences in the first quarter of 2017 show an increase of +214 or by +6.28% compared to the first quarter of 2016.

Drugs in the first quarter of 2017 increased by +10 or by +5.75% compared to the first quarter of 2016.

In the first quarter Property offences count for 47% of the Total Criminal Code offences, while crimes against Persons account for 16% and Criminal Other offences account for 37%.

First Quarter comparison between 2016 and 2017:

Property Crimes

Overall, Property Crime decrease by -32 or -1.85%.

Stolen Motor Vehicles decreased by -2 or -4.08%.

Break and Enters increased by +27 or +17.31%.

Frauds decreased by -35 or -12.54%.

Violent Crimes

Overall Violent crime increased by +129 or +29.32%.

Robberies increased by +7 or +25%.

Homicides decreased by -4 incidents or -100%.

Attempted Murders decreased by -2 or -66.67%.

Assaults increased by +127 or +31.91%.

Assaults accounted for 92% of reported violent crimes in the first quarter of 2017.

Criminal Other Code

Offensive Weapons decreased by -1 in the first quarter of 2017 or by -2.44%

Prostitution offences decreased by -20 offences in the first quarter of 2017 or -100%
