STEP 2: CHECK FOR OPPORTUNITIES

All vacancies are posted on our website, halifax.ca, as well as supporting documents, such as minutes, agendas, terms of reference, and key staff contacts.



STEP 1: ARE YOU ELIGIBLE?

To serve on a municipal board or committee you must be at 18 years or older, and a resident of the municipality. Some boards may require its members to be Canadian citizens.



STEP 3: COMPLETE AND SEND YOUR APPLICATION

Interested applicants are encouraged to complete an online application, and may provide additional information by email to clerks@halifax.ca. You will receive confirmation that your application has been received.



STEP 4: THE COUNCIL SELECTION PROCESS

Your application is reviewed and presented confidentially to committee or council. The selection process may involve an interview with relevant staff and members of council.



STEP 5: READY TO MAKE A DIFFERENCE

You will be notified of the status of your application once the appointment has been made. Staff will be in contact with appointees to provide meeting materials and facilitate with any onboarding required.
