

## Point Pleasant Park Advisory Committee – Summary 2018

The Point Pleasant Park Advisory Committee advises Halifax and West Community Council about planning and management of Point Pleasant Park.

### January 25, 2018

The Point Pleasant Park Advisory Committee received an overview of the relationship between the organizational structure of Parks and Recreation and the role of the Committee, from Richard Harvey. This was followed by a discussion on possible future Committee topics. The Committee received and update on the PPPAC Comprehensive Plan and 2016 staff information report.

### March 01, 2018

The Committee received three presentations, the first, from Carolle Koziak-Roberts which served as an overview of the Point Pleasant Park Comprehensive Plan, the second, delivered by Jeff Spares serving as an overview of the Capital Plan for Parks and Recreation, the final presentation was delivered by Alex Quinn on Paving of Lower Parking Lot. The Committee reviewed possible outcomes for the Point Pleasant Park Mobile App, and approved the following motion:

**THAT Point Pleasant Park Advisory Committee recommends that Halifax and West Community Council request a staff report on the development of a Point Pleasant Park Mobile App and an enhanced website and social media presence to provide information and guidance to park visitors.**

### May 03, 2018

The Point Pleasant Park Advisory Committee received a presentation from Zoe Lucas on Sable Island Institute, and approved the following motion:

**THAT Point Pleasant Park Advisory Committee recommends that Halifax West Community Council:**

- 1. endorse an extension of a 1-year lease of Point Pleasant Park Lodge to the Sable Island Institute ending February 28, 2019;**
- 2. request a staff report on the best use of the Lodge in meeting the goals of the Point Pleasant Park Comprehensive Plan.**

The Point Pleasant Park Advisory Committee received an email update from Stephen Rice on Operations and reviewed this update and approved the following motion:

**THAT Point Pleasant Park Advisory Committee recommends that Halifax and West Community Council request a formal Point Pleasant Park Operations Plan be prepared for use by the Committee in fulfilling its mandate.**

### September 06, 2018

The Point Pleasant Park Advisory Committee received three pieces of correspondence, one from Gail Lonergan on food vendors at Point Pleasant Park, one from Lacey Wilson on the possibility of a fenced-in

dog area in the Park, and one from Len Canfield on the new terminal project. The Point Pleasant Park Advisory Committee received a staff update on Operations from Stephen Rice, which included a staff memorandum. The Committee also discussed the Committee' Work Planning Process.

December 01, 2018

The Committee received a presentation from Catherine McGrail on Halifax Port Authority. The Committee also had a preliminary discussion on the Greenbank building.
