







Background Information

- Habitat For Humanity Nova Scotia is a not for profit organization dedicated since 1992 to providing affordable housing opportunities to HRM and Nova Scotia families.
- The hallmark of Habitat is home ownership program and the belief of how it contributes to strong stable communities by providing a 'hand up' to deserving Nova Scotia families
- Two parcel 5.39 acre property
- Access from Drysdale Road and River Road near Herring Cove Road and adjacent to J.L. Ilsley High School
- Habitat Way is a 78 dwelling unit master planned community consisting of townhomes, condominium townhouses and a four storey multiple-family residential building with a signature half acre active park in the middle of the neighbourhood.
- All servicing, traffic, environmental, stormwater and archeological studies were positive.

- 9 condominium townhouses off River Road
- 29 townhouses on P-Loop off Drysdale Road
- 4 storey 40 unit multiple-family residential building on P-Loop off Drysdale Road
- Signature ½ acre center island park in middle of P-Loop proposed to be basketball court and community garden






