10.1.1 Case 22990: Housekeeping Amendments to the Halifax Citadel Rampart Regulations within the Regional Centre Land Use By-law

The following was before the Community Council:

- Staff recommendation report dated July 23, 2020
- Staff presentation dated September 23, 2020
- Correspondence from Christina Lovitt dated September 23, 2020

Luc Ouellet, Planner III, Regional Planning, presented case 22990 and indicated that there are twelve viewing positions from inside Citadel Hill Parade Square.

The reason for the amendments is that the Halifax Citadel rampart regulations previously in the Halifax Peninsula Land Use By-law were inadvertently not included in the Regional Centre Land Use By-law. Under the adopted Regional Centre Land Use By-law, rampart regulations apply to all land contained within Package A of the Centre Plan. The proposed amendments will re-introduce a geographic limitation on the applicability of the Halifax Citadel rampart regulations that existed prior to November 30, 2019 and provide additional clarity to the interpretation of the regulations.

Public engagement was achieved through a website, providing information and seeking comments. No feedback was received by staff. A copy of the staff presentation is on file.
