13.1.1 Cases 23746 & 22896: MPS and Development Agreement Amendments for Seton Ridge - Bedford Highway, Seton Road & Lacewood Drive, Halifax

THAT Halifax and West Community Council:

- 1. Approve the proposed amending development agreements for the Seton Ridge mixed-use neighbourhood at Bedford Highway, Seton Road and Lacewood Drive, Halifax, which shall be substantially of the same form as set out in Attachments B1 and B2 of the staff report dated November 29, 2021.
- 2. Require the amending development agreement be signed by the property owner within 240 days, or any extension thereof granted by Council on request of the property owner, from the date of final approval by Council and any other bodies as necessary, including

applicable appeal periods, whichever is later; otherwise this approval will be void and obligations arising hereunder shall be at an end.

Paul Sampson, Planner II, gave a presentation on the Seton Ridge MPS & Development Agreement amendments and responded to questions of clarification from Community Council.

13.1.2 Case 20795: Rezoning and Development Agreement for St. Margaret's Bay Road, Beechville

- Give First Reading to consider approval of the proposed amendment to the Timberlea / Lakeside / Beechville Land Use By-law, as set out in Attachment A of the staff report dated February 15, 2022, to rezone property PID 40143174 on St. Margaret's Bay Road in Beechville, from the R-1 (Single Unit Dwelling) Zone to the CDD (Comprehensive Development District) Zone and schedule a public hearing; and
- 2. Give Notice of Motion to consider the proposed development agreement, as set out in Attachment B of the staff report dated February 15, 2022, and schedule a public hearing for the development agreement, which shall be held concurrently with that indicated in section 1.

Jamy-Ellen Klenavic, Planner II, gave a presentation on Case 20795 and responded to questions of clarification from Community Council.

Iain MacLean, Municipal Clerk, and Liam MacSween, Elections and Special Projects Manager, gave a presentation on Phase One of the District Boundary Review and responded to questions of clarification from Community Council. Community Council discussed several issues including the potential for a permanent member at large seat for First Nations on Regional Council, a review of the current advisory committee structure, the use of a ranked ballot or run-off ballot system, permanent-resident voting rights and lowering the voting age to 16 years old.

MacLean and MacSween advised Community Council that the items identified as concerns are not within the scope of the Phase One of the District Boundary Review, however these concerns as well as the feedback from the public will be documented as staff move through the review process.
