10. HEARINGS 10.1 PUBLIC HEARINGS 10.1.1 Case 23247: Amendments to the Sackville Drive Land Use By-law Regarding the Measurement of Building Height

Paul Sampson, Planner II gave a presentation and responded to questions of clarification from Community Council.

Councillor Lovelace entered the meeting after the staff presentation had started and was unable to vote on the matter.

The hearing opened at 7:14 p.m.

The Chair noted that the municipality was the applicant for this matter.

The Chair reviewed the rules of procedure for public hearings and called for anyone wishing to speak on the matter.

Angie Haymond, Kaye Street spoke to living near development along Sackville Drive. Haymond noted concerns with development grading and suggested the grading could have a negative impact on their property.

Karen MacDonald, Senior Solicitor responded to questions of clarification from the Community Council regarding impact of development on neighbouring properties. MacDonald highlighted that property owners negatively impacted by development could contact the Municipality's Risk and Insurance department or obtain independent legal advice.

Lawrence Oakley, Kaye Street raised concerns regarding land elevation from Sackville Drive to Kaye Street and impact on property viewpoints. Oakley highlighted environmental concerns associated with development.

Sampson responded to questions raised by the public regarding properties near development and noted the proposed amendments would apply to all PR zones and PC zones.
