Canada was only 28 years old when the official Natal Day celebration began in 1895 and the Halifax-Dartmouth Natal Day Committee salutes Canada's 150th Birthday in 2017!

A total of 30 individual events include; family activities, live music, road races, entertainment showcase, comedy night, busker performances, the Mayor & Council Garden Party in both Halifax & Dartmouth and one of the oldest parades in Atlantic Canada. In addition, three spectacular firework shows will be held throughout the weekend; from a barge in Halifax Harbour on August 5<sup>th</sup>, at the Halifax Common on August 6<sup>th</sup> and at Lake Banook on August 7<sup>th</sup>.
