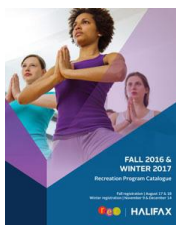
BURNING BAN

For your safety, the Halifax Regional Fire and Emergency (HRFE) has issued a ban on any open air burning in the municipality until further notice.

Extremely dry conditions mean an increased risk for fires in our neighbourhoods and wilderness areas. The ban includes outdoor fireplaces and chimeneas, but natural gas and propane fire pits are permitted.

The province publishes a burning restrictions colour coded map every day at 2:00 p.m. [here](#). The HRFE can increase or add to these restrictions if necessary. Make sure you check their [Twitter](#) or our [Media Releases](#) for details about any additional restrictions that may be in effect.

ELECTION PREPARATIONS

The next municipal election will be held on October 15th, 2016. Make sure you are ready to have your say on who will represent you, making decisions about important issues like property taxes, snow removal, solid waste and development, by ensuring your information is up to date on our voters list.

You can search for your voter information [here](#). If you are not on the list, simply call 902.490.VOTE (8683) to update your information. Revisions to the voters list can be made until 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday October 5th. You must be 18 years old and have resided in the province for at least six months immediately preceding the first advance polling day to vote.

ST MARGARET'S BAY ROAD CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

The Halifax Regional Municipality is advising residents that road construction on the St. Margaret's Bay Road began on August 9th and will continue until the middle of October.

The work is taking place from Beech Tree Run to Lakeland Boulevard daily from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

During this work there will be lane drops in place. Motorists should expect delays in the area and are asked to use alternative routes whenever possible.

The municipality apologizes for any inconvenience this road work may cause.

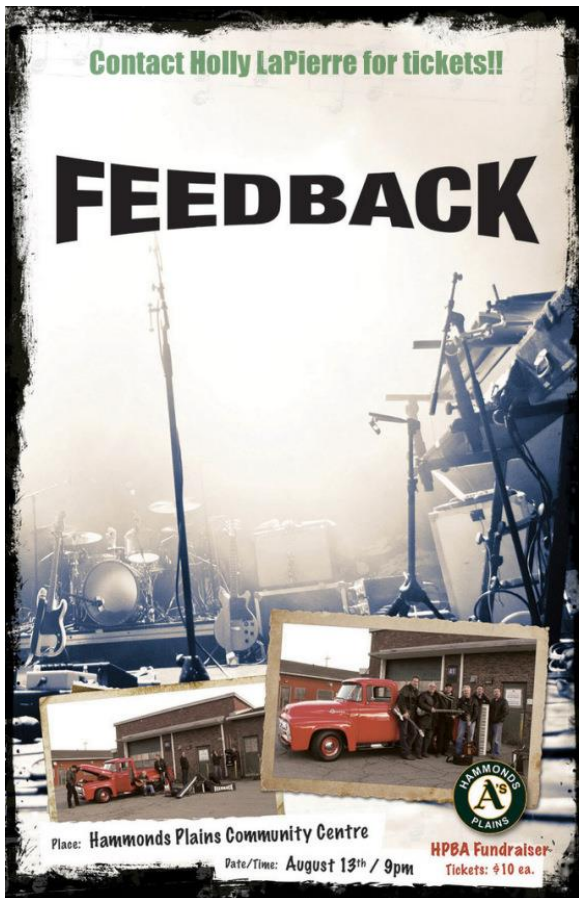
SOLAR CITY RE-LAUNCH

Switching to a renewable energy source like solar helps support a green economy, can provide savings in utility costs, and helps us meet our commitments to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and curb climate change. The Halifax Regional Municipality is pleased to be offering its award-winning [Solar City program](#) once again. This program assists individual property owners with the purchase and installation of solar energy systems.

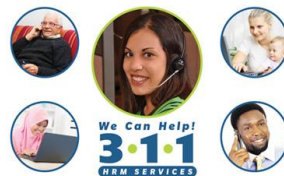
During our successful two-year pilot program, almost 400 solar systems were installed in homes around the municipality. In March 2015 Regional Council approved the extension of the program with expanded solar technology options for a three-year period. The program now provides property owners with three solar energy installation options; solar hot water, solar hot air and solar photovoltaic (PV).

Qualified Solar City participants can finance all or part of the cost to purchase and install the solar energy system through the municipality. Repayment can take place over a maximum 10-year period and payments are collected through pre-authorized transactions on a frequency determined by the property owner.

Interested property owners can easily register [online](#). Each applicant will receive a unique user ID that will be used to track the applicant's status throughout the five-step process.
