Halifax Water Seasonal Disinfection Program

From March 1st – April 30th 2016, Halifax Water will be conducting a two-month trial of the seasonal disinfection program. The program will shut down the Ultra Violet (UV) light disinfection at the Halifax, Dartmouth, Herring Cove and Eastern Passage wastewater treatment facilities. This trial aims to reduce electricity, lower greenhouse gas emissions, allow for maintenance and potentially extend UV equipment lifespan.
