PARCEL B
SCHEDULE "A"

All that certain lot, piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being **Parcel B** shown on a plan of survey entitled "Parcel B, a portion of Waverley Road, lands of Halifax Regional Municipality to be conveyed to The Trustees of the Port Wallis Congregation of the United Church of Canada and their Successor in Office, Civic 263 Waverley Road, Dartmouth, Halifax County, Nova Scotia", prepared by Allan MacCullough, N.S.L.S., dated March 31, 2000 and more particularly described as follows:

COMMENCING at Nova Scotia Co-ordinate Monument #5319;

THENCE N 33°-06'-35" W a distance of 105.41 feet to a survey marker on the western boundary of Waverley Road and hereinafter being referred to as **THE PLACE OF BEGINNING**;

THENCE S 35°-46'-49" W along the extension of the northern boundary of lands of Linda Mae Turple a distance of 24.70 feet to a survey marker at the northeast corner of lands of Linda Mae Turple and the western boundary of Waverley Road;

THENCE following a curve to the right an arc distance of 30.19 feet having a radius of 353.00 feet to a survey marker on the western boundary of Waverley Road and being N 11°-14'-21" E a distance of 30.19 feet from the last mentioned survey marker;

THENCE N 13°-40'-47" E along the western boundary of Waverley Road a distance of 45.01 feet to a survey marker being a point of curvature;

THENCE following a curve to the left an arc distance of 12.77 feet having a radius of 240.00 feet to a survey marker on the western boundary of Waverley Road and being N 12°-09'-09" E a distance of 12.77 feet from the last mentioned survey marker.

THENCE S 03°-41'-12" E along the western boundary of Waverley Road a distance of 84.18 feet to **THE PLACE OF BEGINNING**.

Bearings are based on the Nova Scotia Co-ordinate System, Zone 5, Central Meridian 64-30 West. Said Parcel contains 1,369 square feet.

The above described parcel is and is intended to be a portion of the Waverley Road to be conveyed to the Port Wallis Congregation of the United Church of Canada and their Successor in Office.
